



A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Thank you for answering my call to support one of our ten seminarians during one month of the year. The sign-up sheets will remain on the prayer table as you enter the church from the side door.

I am beginning our new vocations ministry by writing to each of the ten seminarians for the month of January. February has been filled. March and the rest of the year are open. Our parish goal is to have 120 people writing a note to our ten young men in visibly showing them that we care about their journey. Identify yourself from Sacred Heart Parish in Manchester and our Pastor is Fr. Steve Marcoux who asked us to support you by our prayers.

A few suggestions for you:

1. Attend a daily Mass and offer the Mass for the semiarians good health and perseverance.

2. Pray a rosary.

3. Come to church on Wednesday during Adoration from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. Any amount of time you spend before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is fine and offer it for the seminarian.

4. Be creative...Offer your sacrifices and health limitations for his courage to continue his studies.

5. Share a personal story of faith.

These are some ideas. My hope is that you will develop a prayer partnership with the seminarian you have chosen each day and not just the month you signed up for.

Would it not be the best reality that our ten young men have twelve prayer partners each? Let's hope for this gift of your prayers!


