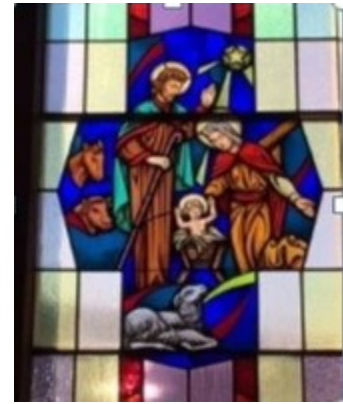

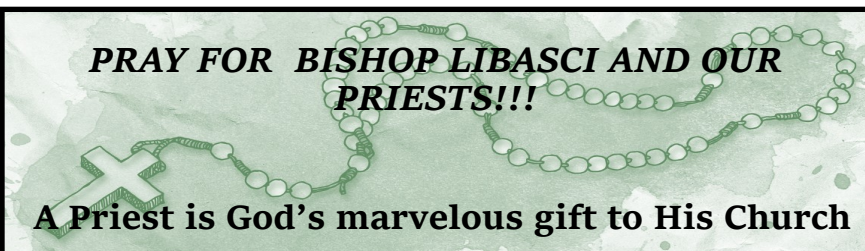

If you would like a Mass, please call the office and Julie can arrange that. It is sometimes hard to get specific dates and weekends but she will see what is available.

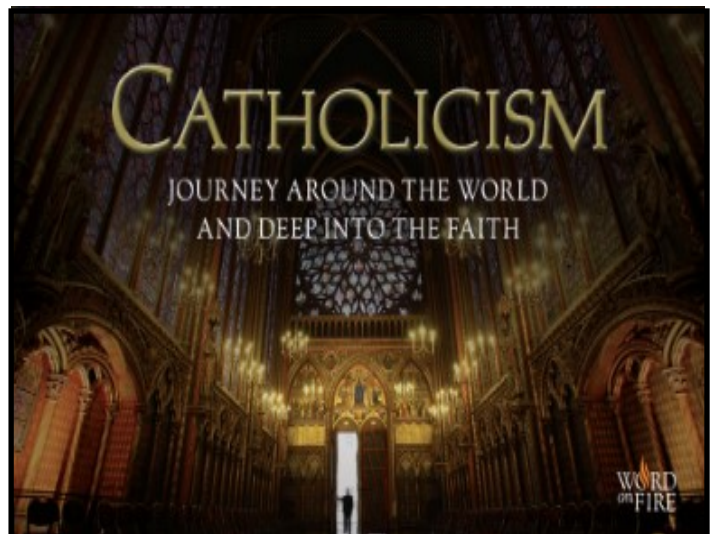
