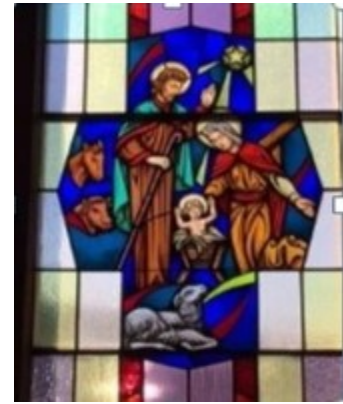

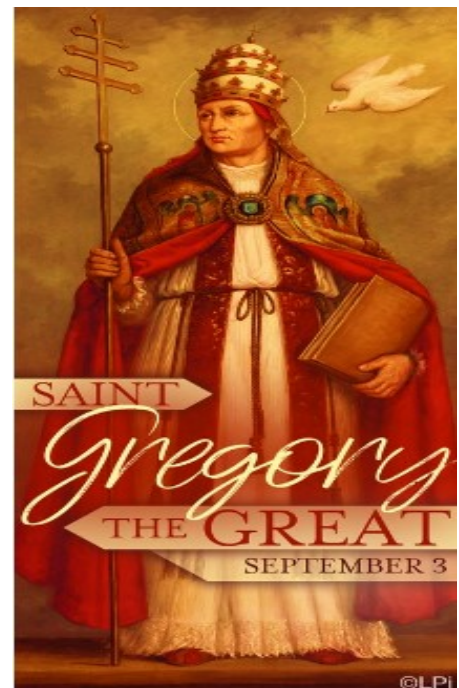

AMEN.

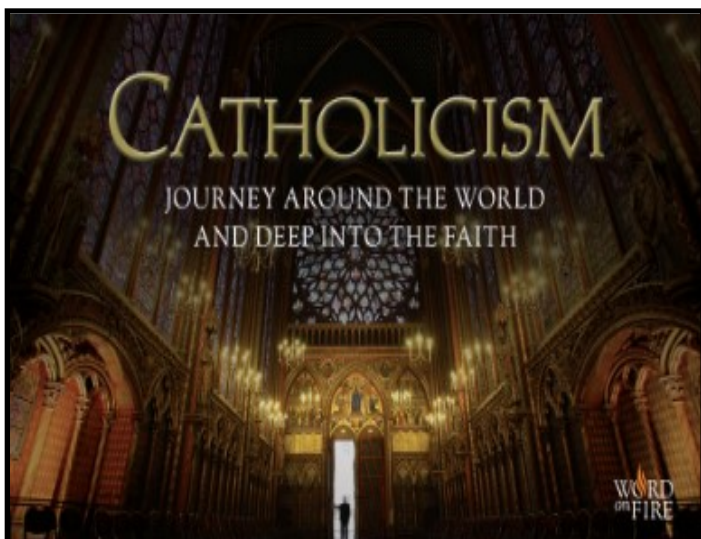
